


TAR Party Committee held meeting to study Xi Jinping's speech delivered on July 26, 2017.

August 01, 2017

On August 1, 2017, the TAR Regional Party Committee met to study the importance of implementing the speech given by General Secretary Xi Jinping on July 26. TAR Party Secretary Wu Yingjie presided and stressed that leading cadres at the provincial and ministerial levels TAR should seriously study the speech and uphold the spirit of socialism with Chinese characteristics. The speech emphasized the importance of educating and broadening the minds of Party members and cadres.

It called upon Propaganda Departments at all levels to play a major role in TAR to spread the true intention of General Secretary Xi Jinping, which is to instill the sense of solidarity and unity within the mainstream public opinion. The meeting reiterated the need for the successful practice of the Party's rules in Tibet. Finally, it called upon Party members to safeguard overall social harmony and long-term stability in Tibet by promoting Buddhism which creates harmony in society.

TAR Exports and Imports total 3.4 billion Yuan in first half of the year

August 01, 2017

According to an official report published on July 30, the total value of TAR's imports and exports in the first half of this year reached 3.4 billion yuan, an increase of 79.55% over the same period last year. The total export value was 1.298 billion yuan, an increase of 3.38% and total import value was 2.125 billion yuan which is an increase of 2.3 times. The trade deficit was 807 million yuan.

France, Nepal and Belgium became the TAR's three major trading partners this year. Of them, imports and exports from France totalled 1.187 billion yuan, or 34.88% of the total value representing an increase of 2.79 times; the total volume of imports and exports to Nepal was 1.063 billion yuan, or down 15 percentage points; and imports and exports from Belgium totaled 3.31 billion yuan, an increase of 6.08 time

Tibetan banking industry developed in the first six months.

July 30 2017

China Tibet News on June 31 said that in the first half of 2017 banking and financial institutions in Tibet had effectively implemented the credit policy of "making good use of savings and revitalizing the stock". They have optimised credit structure, improved financial services and adhered to the bottom-line of

taking risks. The banking industry maintained a healthy development trend. It reported that the operating efficiency of the banking sector had continued to improve, with the scale of assets and liabilities, deposits and loans registering steady growth. The rural enterprises, especially micro-enterprises in the poverty stricken areas, increased the effort to significantly support localities. As of June 2017, the balance of small and medium enterprises loans reached 96.018 billion yuan, an increase of 11.376 billion yuan over the beginning of the year and agriculture loans amounted to 94.424 billion yuan, an increase of 10.29%.

Zhang Yanqing conducts environmental inspection in Gyangze County

August 02, 2017

On July 29, Vice Chairman of TAR Party Committee and the Party Secretary of Shigatse, Zhang Yanqing sent a group of inspectors to conduct in-depth research in Gyangze County.

The same day, Zhang Yanqing inspected the Fanghui Mining Company and carried out field inspections of dumping sites, gushing water sedimentation, flood diversion ditch and embankment, and learned more about the Gyangze county party committee, county government and supervisory department and enterprises.

Zhang Yanqing stressed that it is important for all levels of city departments and party members to understand the extent of harm caused to the ecological system due to illegal mining. He emphasized that the 18th National Congress of the Chinese Communist Party under Xi Jinping had always given importance to environmental protection work. He said achieving the goal of environmental protection has become a major institutional management task.

Earlier, on July 11, the TAR Party Committee organised a meeting for the central environmental protection inspectors. TAR Party Secretary Wu Yingjie attended the meeting and delivered an important speech on the importance of environmental protection work.

Zhang Yanqing acknowledged that the county party committee and county government should implement environmental protection with a strict sense of responsibility. He stressed the importance of discipline inspection and supervision in implementation of the environmental protection plan laid down by the municipal government.

Autonomous Region Leadership Survey in Shigatse City

August 07, 2017

On August 7, the Vice Chairman of the CPPCC, Chairman of the Federation of Industry and Commerce, and President of the Chamber of Commerce, Ngapi Jinyuan went to Shigatse to conduct research on the development of the non-public economy.

Ngapi Jinyuan visited the Shigatse City Poverty Alleviation Development Co. Ltd, Gangsi Construction Co. Ltd. and the Jinta Group for on-site inspections to understand production operations. He said that in recent years, the Shigatse Municipal Government has attached great importance to the development of the non-public economy and its active participation in poverty alleviation work has

achieved remarkable results.

He called on the Shigatse City Federation of Industry and Commerce and private enterprises to study and implement Party Secretary Wu Yingjie's speech on the development of the non-public economy. China Eastern Airlines direct flights to Xigaze route opened

On July 30, a China Eastern Airlines Airbus A319 aircraft landed smoothly at the Shigatse airport, marking the official opening of China Eastern Airlines - Shanghai - Shigatse route.

Deputy Secretary of the Municipal Party Committee and Shigatse Mayor Liu Hushan Deputy Secretary of the Municipal Party committee and Executive Vice Mayor Ni Junan with party and government cadres and representatives of the masses offered white scarves to the arriving cadres of the Shanghai Municipal Government and Eastern Airlines. Deputy party Chief Ni Junnan said: "Today is a worthy day for Xigaze City, its 800,000 cadres and masses. He thanked China Eastern Airlines on the behalf the Shanghai Eighth 'Aid- Tibet' cadres for opening the Shanghai - Xi'an - Shigatse route. He said the new route would greatly shorten the distance between Shanghai and Tibet and strengthen cooperation

and exchange between Shigatse and the eastern coastal areas and build Shigatse as an important world tourist destination. It will also play the role of opening a bridgehead in opening South Asia”.

In August 2016, China Eastern Airlines and the Shigatse Municipal Government signed a strategic cooperation agreement to actively promote the development of Shigatse Civil Aviation. To ensure flight safety, China Eastern Airlines has carried out a number of modifications to the cabin air supply system, cockpit booster system and engine power system on aircraft flying that route. The aircraft use RNP AR precision satellite navigation technology. The Shanghai - Xi'an – Shigatse route has flights every Thursday and Sunday. In recent years, central authorities have been vigorously supporting local construction in Tibet.

City leaders pay condolences to Garrison troops and military cadres

July 29, 2017, was marked as the 90th anniversary of the founding of the Chinese People's Liberation Army (PLA). Deputy Secretary of the Municipal Party committee and Executive Vice Mayor Feng Jikang, came to the Air Force to visit the five retired cadres and offered white scarves as the festival blessings and greetings. The excellent rate of ambient air in Tibet in the first half of 2017

August 04, 2017

On August 3, morning, TAR Party Secretary Wu Yingjie visited the Environmental Protection Department in Ali (Tib: Ngari), which is the national environmental air automatic monitoring network station in Tibet. Wu Yingjie inspected the work of ecological and environmental protection. According to the national environmental air automatic monitoring network station, there is excellent ambient air in the whole area of Tibet, which is 95.8% in the first half of 2017. The percentage points of ambient air quality are higher than that of the same period of last year. The excellent rate of ambient air in Lhasa was 97.8%, (top) and the ambient air quality in Ali ranked second among the 74 key cities in the country (China).

Subsequently, Wu Yingjie presided over a special meeting to listen to a report of the region's ecological and environmental protection work team. Wu Yingjie stressed that Tibet is an important national ecological security barrier and the ecological strategic status of Tibet is extremely important to the stability of the country. Since the 18th CCP National Congress, the CCP Central Committee has repeatedly issued important instructions on the protection and construction of ecological environment in Tibet. It has pointed out that advancing the construction of ecological civilization and environmental protection for Tibet is the greatest contribution to the survival of China and her development.

Ali Regional Party Committee helps military symposium to celebrate the 90th anniversary of the founding of PLA

August 02, 2017

On July 30, the Ali Regional Party Committee held a military symposium to celebrate the 90th anniversary of the People's Liberation Army. The meeting was attended by Peng Qiao, Deputy Secretary of the District committee and Administrative Commissioner; Zhang Huiming, Deputy Secretary of the Regional Party Committee; Zhang Junyong, Military Division Political Commissar and some members of the prefectural Party committee. Zhang Huiming presided.

Peng Qiao, Deputy Secretary of the District Committee and Administrative Commissioner gave a speech on behalf of the prefectural Party committee, the National People's Congress, the Executive Committee, the CPPCC and the people of the whole region to congratulate the 'victorious works' of the PLA and also conveyed condolences to those who lost their lives fighting for the country.

Promoting measures to sustain the rapid development of tourism in Ali

August 07, 2017

In an editorial published on August 7, the Ali region has introduced five measures to promote domestic and international tourism in the region. In 2016, Ali received 500,000 domestic and foreign tourists earning tourism revenue of 675 million yuan, an increase of 37.4%. In the first half of 2017, the number of domestic and foreign tourists reached 16.42 million generating tourism income of 209 million yuan, an increase of 3.29%. The five measures to promote tourism include: establishing the concept of global tourism, improving tourist service, market operation, building tourist projects, and tourism related law enforcement. A total investment of 1.14 billion yuan has also been made in 12 tourist projects in 2017 in the Ali area to improve tourism infrastructure and services.

Ali area held a meeting on industry development and information construction

August 10, 2017

On June 6, the Ali Regional Work Forum held a meeting on Industry Development and Information Construction. Wang Haizhou, Vice Chairman of the Tibetan Autonomous Region, attended the meeting.

The meeting pointed out that in recent years, the Ali prefectural and administrative departments attach great importance to industrial development and information.

The meeting discussed that Ali needs to adhere to ecological protection of the red line; do a good job in stabilizing the work for the economic and social development to lay a good foundation; pay more attention to industrial development; follow the law for industrial development; strengthen organization and leadership; seize the opportunity to plan and improve services; develop preferential policies to optimize allocation of resources; create a number of key

enterprises and key industries; form industrial chains and industrial clusters; and build smooth information channels to information technology to promote social governance and development.

Demolition of Tibetan Residences Underway at Sichuan's Yachen Gar Buddhist Center

August 15, 2017

Authorities in western China's Sichuan province have begun demolishing 2,000 residences of Tibetan clergy at the Yachen Gar Buddhist Center and are set to expel an equal number of monks and nuns from the complex by the end of the year. "Demolition began on August 8 and the work is said to be ongoing at Yachen Gar, while the same number of monks and nuns [2,000] are also to be expelled from the Buddhist center this year alone. Yachen Gar, located in Kardze (in Chinese, Ganzi) prefecture's Palyul (Baiyu) county and founded in 1985, until recently housed an estimated 10,000 monks, nuns, and lay practitioners devoted to scriptural study and meditation. Following the beginning of demolitions last week, a senior lama at Yachen Gar issued an appeal to the monks and nuns at the complex to "exercise patience and tolerance." He said "About 2,000 houses will be demolished this year and around same number of monks and nuns will be asked to leave the complex—this is an order from the powerful authorities and cannot be resisted, just as falling boulders from a mountain cannot be stopped. Most important is to remain humble and adhere to proper conduct, and things may get better. Also, it is important for all monks and nuns to take care of their health. The monks and nuns should exercise patience and tolerance under the stress of the demolitions and expulsion orders—this is crucial." Restrictions on Yachen Gar and the better-known Larung Gar complex in Sichuan's Serthar (Seda) county are part of "an unfolding political strategy" aimed at controlling the influence and growth of these important centers for Tibetan Buddhist study and practice, the Washington-based International Campaign for Tibet (ICT) said in a March 13 report. At the end of June, a senior abbot at Larung Gar said that

Chinese authorities had destroyed 4,725 monastic dwellings over the course of a year at the complex, with a total of more than 7,000 demolished since efforts to reduce the number of monks and nuns living at the sprawling center began in 2001. The abbot said that more than 4,828 monks and nuns had also been expelled since 2016, with many forced back to their hometowns and deprived of opportunities to pursue religious studies.

(Comment: Many thousands of Tibetans and Han Chinese once studied at Larung Gar Academy, which was founded in 1980 by the late religious teacher Khenpo Jigme Phuntsok and is one of the world's largest and most important centers for the study of Tibetan Buddhism.)

Yalong Reservoir Dam Completion

August 09, 2017

Reports stated on August 9, that a new reservoir dam on the Yalong has been successfully completed. The reporter learned from the Municipal Water Conservancy Bureau that the 383.7 meters wide and 73.5 meters high reservoir dam was successfully completed one year earlier than the scheduled plan.

The project started in July 2014. The investment on the project was 4,70,254,700 yuan and all the investment was by the central government. The Yalong reservoir project is TAR's key water conservancy construction project, which is also very important for the Yalong Irrigation Project. After completion, the project will solve water scarcity problems for about 909 acres of land downstream through irrigation. The Yalong Irrigation Project each year supplies 3 million cubic metres of water to the towns. The reservoir has a flood prevention function.

Longzi County held a meeting on grassroots party building

August 09, 2017

On August 8, Longzi county held a meeting to review party building work in the

first half of 2017 and arrange for the deployment of grassroots party building in the second half of the year. Tsering Gyatso, Secretary of the county party committee attended and gave a speech. Li Yuzhi, Deputy Secretary of the county also attended the meeting, which was presided over by Liu Shengyu, the county magistrate.

The meeting stressed that the head of the party branch of the county government and the head of the party committee have worked hard on party building work in the first half of 2017. The meeting was held via teleconference with a total of 40 party cadres and officials including members of the party committee.

Shannan holds economic work deployment meeting for second half of 2017

August 10, 2017

On August 9, the Qu Song county held a meeting to review the economic operation and economic work deployment in the first half of the year in Shannan (Tib: Lhoka). The meeting first stressed the importance of studying and practicing the vision of TAR Party Secretary Wu Yingjie, and then presented a briefing on the economic performance in the first half of 2017 and gave a departmental analysis on the current economic work situation based on which the economic developments and construction plan would be planned for the second half of the year.

The meeting pointed out that under the strong leadership of the Municipal Government, Qu Song County's economic operation has been smooth in the first half of year. Qu Song County's GDP reached 216 million yuan, an increase of 15.5%. The total added value of all production industries production was valued at 1108 million yuan.

Foreign Interactions

EU Delegation's Lhasa Tour

July 04, 2017

The European Union's Ambassador to China, Hans Dietmar Schweisgut and a group of Ambassadors and delegates from the United Kingdom, Portugal, Slovakia, Czech Republic, Croatia and 15 other EU member states toured Lhasa and Nyingtri (Ch:Nyingchi) after their visit to Tibet from, June 26 – 30, 2017. Jiang Jie, Executive Vice Chairman of the TAR People's Congress and Tenpa Tashi, Chairman of TAR's Propaganda Department accompanied the delegation to Nyingtri. The delegation visited the Potala Palace, Jokhang Temple, Sera Je Monastery, Tibet University, Dobu Hydropower Station, Lulang International Tourism, Milin Farm, Tashigang Family Hotel and other places covering the economy, culture, and ecology tourism aspects of TAR. The Delegation reportedly made positive comments on the harmonious and stable political and economic development of Tibet, 'people's happiness,' 'protection of cultural heritage,' and 'freedom of religion.'

Ambassador Hans Dietmar Schweisgut stated that "Tibet has a long history and cultural and religious heritage, and the listing of the Potala Palace as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage is conducive to Tibet, to China and to the entire world."

The Spanish Ambassador to China, Manuel Valencia said he had been living in China for four years and had been yearning to visit the real Tibet. He said Potala is beautiful.

The Slovenian Ambassador to China, who is interested in Tibetan Buddhist Culture, visited Jokhang Temple and was impressed to see Tibetans coming for circumambulation and prayers. He observed that Tibetans have “religious freedom” and Tibet is closest to paradise.

The British Ambassador to China Ms Barbara Janet Woodward, visited schools, colleges and Universities in Tibet and showed great interest in exchanges between educational institutions of Tibet and Britain. The delegations were shown “Princess Wencheng Drama” which represents Chinese and Tibetan history and culture through the stories of Princess Wencheng of the Tang Dynasty and King Songtsen Gambo of Tibet 1,300 years ago. The Princess was given as a gift to the King by China. The drama is touted as one of the “must see, outdoor live-action performances” for tourists visiting Tibet.

TAR Leaders meets delegation from Botswana

July 11, 2017

On the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, a delegation consisting of 13 people from think tanks, media and celebrities of Botswana visited Lhasa and Nyingchtri (Ch: Nyingchi) from July 7 – 9, 2017. Jiang Jie, Executive Vice Chairman of the TAR People’s Congress hosted the delegation. After briefing them on the economic development and overall situation of Tibet, the delegations of the two countries promised to strengthen traditional friendship and bilateral relations. They discussed potential areas and expansion of cooperation.

Botswana’s delegation was led by former Vice President of the University of Botswana and Frank Youngman, Professor of Adult Education at the University of Botswana. The delegation expressed its sincere gratitude to China for extending the invitation and said the delegation had a better understanding of Tibet after the visit. It invited representatives of the TAR People’s Government to visit Botswana and understand their culture.

(Comment: The Dalai Lama was due to make a public address at the three-day “Mind and Life Dialogue” conference in Gaborone on August 19 and meet Botswana President Ian Khama. After China warned Botswana against the Dalai Lama’s visit, Botswana said the visit was “purely private” but added that the Dalai Lama would be granted the status of a foreign dignitary. India and China too powerful to defeat each other, must become ‘bhai-bhai’

The Dalai Lama has suggested that India use its soft power, including its Buddhist heritage and tourism, to defuse tensions with China. The 14th Dalai Lama, who was in Mumbai to inaugurate a course on ‘secular ethics’ at Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), said that India should arrange for Chinese Buddhists to visit holy places such as Dharmasala in Himachal Pradesh and Gaya in Bihar. “There are 400 million Buddhists living in China. If India invites them here they will come closer to the country,” he said.

The Dalai Lama said that despite border skirmishes, the two countries have to coexist peacefully. “India and China can only create troubles for each other every now and then, but they cannot defeat each other, as both have powerful militaries. You should think about ‘Hindi-Chini bhai bhai’ once again,” he said.

Exile Tibetan leader addresses Australian parliament’s rights body

The sub-committee is chaired by Hon Kevin Andrews and has Dr. Anne Aly as Vice Chair, with Senators Dean Smith and Claire Moore, as well Ms. Sharon Claydon, Michael Danby, Ms. Lisa Singh, and Trent Zimmerman, as members.

The Sikyong was also reported to have met the chair and co-chair of the All Party Parliamentary group for Tibet and leader of the Australian Green Senator Richard Di Natale on August 9.

Nineteen dead, 263 injured by earthquake in Tibetan county in Sichuan Province

August 10, 2017

Nineteen people were killed, 263 injured and some 60,000 people, mostly tourists, evacuated following a 7.0-magnitude earthquake which struck Jiuzhaigou (Tibetan: Namphel or Namphing) County in Aba (Ngawa) Prefecture in Sichuan on August 8.

The dead include eight tourists and two locals. China's official Xinhua news agency said on August 10, that those evacuated included 126 non-Chinese foreigners.

Xinhua said strong tremors could be felt in the provincial capital Chengdu, located 285 kilometres (177 miles) away. Many places in Qinghai and Gansu also felt the tremor, which was also felt as far away as Xi'an, capital of Shaanxi province.
